

Georgia Bio Legislative Watch January 18, 2019 Days 1-4 of 40 Day Session

GENERAL INFORMATION:

The Georgia Legislature convened the 2019 Legislative Session on Monday, January 14. There was little activity on legislation this week except for organizational committee meetings.

Budget Week is scheduled for the week of January 21 with joint House and Senate appropriations meetings convening on the mornings of the 22 and 23. Those budget hearings will be devoted to the FY2019 continuation budget and the FY2020 General Appropriations Act.

Governor Brian Kemp presented his first State of the State address to members of the General Assembly, constitutional officers, members of the judiciary, and state administrators on Thursday, January 17. Governor Kemp's priorities include enhancing K-12 education by investing in teachers, school safety, and mental health services; working with the House on the Rural Development Council's proposal to provide quality healthcare and access to broadband; crafting state flexibility options for the Medicaid program; growing the rural hospital tax credit; and addressing Georgia's doctor shortage.
