

Welcome to the Georgia Bio Legislative Watch, a weekly update on the 2012 legislative session of the Georgia General Assembly provided by Brock Clay Attorneys exclusively for Georgia Bio members.

The headline of the week was the continued controversy in the State Senate. The conflict between President Pro-Tem Tommie Williams and Lt. Governor Casey Cagle has gone unresolved for 18 months, and Monday began with a report that Lt. Gov. Cagle had made a deal with the Democrats to unseat Williams from his Pro-Tem's office. All parties were called into Governor Nathan Deal's office for three hours that evening, and a tenuous deal was agreed upon. However, when the deal was presented to the entire Senate Republican caucus on Tuesday morning, it was voted down. No further details have been revealed, but the Lt. Governor clearly doesn't have enough votes in the caucus to unseat Williams, so if he wants to change the rules, he'll have to do so with the Democratic caucus.

On Tuesday, Governor Nathan Deal presented his State of the State address. The full text of his speech can be found <u>here</u>. For the first time in the history of the state, the Democrats provided an official response in a speech given by Senate Minority Leader Steve Henson. His speech focused in large part on jobs, education, and transportation.
