



Welcome to the Georgia Bio Legislative Watch, a weekly update on the 2012 legislative session of the Georgia General Assembly provided by Brock Clay Attorneys exclusively for Georgia Bio members.

### SB 402 / HB 718 - Venture Capital

This year, two major pieces of legislation have been dropped that affect the venture capital industry. HB 718 will set up a \$200 million venture capital fund by auctioning insurance tax credits. The fund would be overseen by a state authority and would invest in start-up or early growth technology companies. The legislation remains in the House Insurance Committee. SB 402 would allow for the investment of state employees retirement funds in a variety of different accounts including private investment funds, warrants, venture capital funds, leveraged buyouts, options, recapitalizations, privatizations, and mezzanine funds. The Teachers Retirement System is exempt from the provisions of the legislation. This legislation has been second read and assigned to the House Retirement Committee. There will likely not be any further action on the bill until the week of March 12 due to Crossover Day being scheduled for next week.

# **HB 868** - Update on Tax Issues

The current tax priorities for both House and Senate leadership include the sales tax exemption for energy inputs into manufacturing and the quality jobs tax credit (Floor Leader Doug Collins' HB 868). Among other provisions, HB 868 expands the state's current job creation incentives to include companies in the alternative, biomedical manufacturing, and electric vehicles industries. The legislation also lowers the employee threshold to qualify for the credits in certain geographic areas in Georgia. The new limits would be as low as two in rural areas and 10 in urban areas. Finally, while the legislation doesn't affect credit amounts in rural areas, it does increase the credits in more stable urban counties from \$1,250 annually to \$2,000 annually for five years. HB 868 passed out of the Ways and Means Committee this week and is currently in the House Rules Committee. No legislation for the manufacturing energy tax credit has moved so far.

## SR 1053 - Senate Science and Technology Innovation Study Committee

Senate Science and Technology Chairman Barry Loudermilk (R - Cassville) has introduced legislation to create the Senate Science and Technology Innovation Study Committee to be comprised of the chair and vice-chair of the Senate Science and Technology Committee, one appointee by the Lt. Governor, and various members of the private sector. The study committee will continue work on Georgia's Science and Technology Strategic Plan. This study committee appears to be an effort to continue and build upon the efforts of the 2011 study committee.

### Legislative Schedule

The current legislative schedule is set only until Legislative Day 31. Currently, March 5 will be Legislative Day 29, March 7 will be Legislative Day 30 Crossover Day, and March 12 will be Legislative Day 31. Currently, feedback from legislative leadership indicates that Sine Die will take place around March 29, 2012.
